# Conservation Corner


This Fall we have three exciting conservation volunteer opportunities:

**First-** Sept 30 – Oct 3 - SDFF members, families and friends will again venture up to Casa Vieja Meadow in the Golden Trout Wilderness to drop our cattle exclusion fence. This fall's trip will be special. Two California Water Board Scientists will lead us in performing bioassessments on our adopted stream. It has been five years since we did an assessment so the results may tell us a lot about the benefits of keeping cattle from grazing in and near this fragile stream.

**Second-** Nov 11 and 12 “Veterans Day Weekend” – we can use lots of volunteers to help build the “**Bill and Eileen Stroud / Skip Price Memorial Amphitheater**” at Fisherman’s Camp in the Boulder Creek Preserve. This is only an hour’s drive from San Diego so you can join as for the weekend or just a few hours. It is located on Boulder Creek Road at milepost 10.5, North of Descanso. We will try to arrange carpools from the Japatul Valley Park and Ride <https://goo.gl/NL6Q19>

**Third-** Saturday Oct 15 (10AM -12:30) at the Mission Trails Regional Park Visitors Center we will be hosting Trout in the Classroom Training presented by CDFW biologists. We have at least seven local teachers interested in hatching trout in their classroom this year so we need a few more SDFF volunteer helpers. You will be matched up with a teacher at a school near you so you can help them with setting up their aquarium etc. Then we will deliver the eggs and visit the classroom periodically. After about 7 to 8 weeks we will all meet at Lake Murray to release the trout. This training will only be offered once this year in San Diego so if you think you may want to help try to be there on Oct 15.

In addition to all of our volunteer efforts,



we have been busy spending the proceeds from our **annual Raffle and Auction** and your donations to the Conservation Fund.

**We donated \$1000 to the Wild Coast Discovery Center** on the Bay in Chula Vista to help in the continuing operation and maintenance to their Steelhead Trout Display. The Discovery Center is a great place to visit with children. You will see the Trout display directly in front of you as you enter the Center.

**We have also donated \$1000 to the Hubbs Seaworld Research Institute** for their White Sea Bass and Halibut rearing programs.

I recommend you all come to the October meeting to hear **Curtis Knight**, Executive Director of Cal Trout, speak about their stream restoration projects. **We will be donating \$1000** to that effort.

## Barrett Lake Report- by Kim Jones-Schofield



### Barrett on the Fly.

I hit Barrett Lake on Sunday 9/4 with my most available fishing partners....me, myself and I. I didn't have a reservation but it all worked out well as I met Lori at the gate at 5:15am, paid my \$20 and was in for a fun day. As the small train of cars was way ahead of me I was in for a very dark bumpy ride. The road in is extremely rutted which caused my Ford Ranger to fish tail like crazy.

I finally crawled my way to the parking lot and opted to park mid way up from the dock. Many trucks and cars were parked down next to the dock which resulted with a number of them having difficulty getting out at the end of the day. I have to say that the roads and parking at Barrett are some of the scariest.....no room for error!!



Got on the water around 6 with perfect conditions, overcast with no winds. The fishing was slow for everyone but I'm happy with catching blue gills until I find the bass. I fished from the dock to the dam and then made the long kick out to past Pig Point and then worked my way back to the dock.

There were maybe 5 to 6 boats and 4 float tubes that I saw so there was plenty of room for everyone. I found some fish tight to the shore and others 15 feet off shore. The bite was fair until about 9:30 when it died but picked up around 11:00 and was steady until I got out at 4. I ended the day

with 43 blue gills 2 huge crappie and 13 bass. I was using my 5 weight 9' Winston rod with a fast sinking line. I must have brought no less than 9 boxes of flies with me but ended up sticking with the two favorites size 12 beadhead woolly bugger black and white.

I didn't take pictures of all the fish just a couple. Bass were pretty much all alike. The crappie were huge and put a bend in my rod, I did go back and forth over the water I caught them in looking for their friends but just ended with just the two. The blue gills were everywhere and were so big I had a hard time getting a hold of them and have cuts on my hands to prove it. 5 of the bass came from the small arm to the left as you stand looking at the dock.

The lake was alive with baby shad that were jumping sporadically all over the lake and occasionally tossing a white fly to a swirl resulted in a bass.

Over all it was a great day which I totally enjoyed. The bad news is that if we don't get a healthy dose of rain this winter and spring Barrett could be doomed.

Please excuse some of my silly faces, it was hard to hold on to my phone, the fish and see the screen.....I think I need a selfie stick.

# Fly of the Month- Blue Winged Olive

In the darkest corner of one of my dry fly boxes lies a **blue winged olive** pattern that catches lots of fish, and is pretty darn ugly. Well, ugly might be a bit harsh but it certainly lacks some of the pretty characteristics of say... Catskill patterns.

A quill-bodied, beautifully hackled, split-winged pattern....nope. This pattern reminds me of what a guide once said to me: ".....most flies are designed to catch fisherman"...

One look into his fly box would leave you wondering if his flies were ALL badly chewed-up by trout already. They truly looked more like a box of bare hooks than a box of flies. Almost half of them were only two-material patterns, many looked like thread alone. This nagged at me. Enough fish took my hackled patterns....they must like something about them. Then it happened. During a great BWO hatch, I began to get refusals on my hackled little BWO patterns. I studied them, as I'm sure countless anglers have, and captured a few samples. They were smaller, lighter in color and lower-riding than my patterns. Olive dry fly dubbing turned a very dark color when wet, and sat above the water~not in it. Back to the vise.

Using synthetic-colored dubbing kept the color true, the CDC looked awful on the vise~but very real on the water and it was VERY quick to tie. I cranked-out a bunch and went back to that spot the next night. Problem solved.

I still prefer to tie on a CDC biot comparadun, but confess it probably has more to do more with my aesthetic sensibilities than anything else. When trout won't take it though, I secretly tie one of these.....

NOTE:This design is pretty easy to tie in smaller sizes. I like the tails to be long and "flared" to a sort of fan shape.

It helps to keep the fly upright in the water when it lands.


## Tying The Blue Winged Olive Fly Pattern

Hook:Tiemco101..... Size#18-#22  
**T h r e a d** ..... 1 2 / 0 T a n  
**Tail:**Medium dun spade hackle (microfibbets would work well too)  
**Body:**.....Paleolive/gray synthetic  
**Wing:** .....Pale gray CDC

*wraps of thread to secure and smooth the tie-in point.*



*Make a few wraps of dubbing in front of the wing to complete the fly, tie-off.*



*Start thread and wind back to the bend. Tie in approx. 8 hackle fibers and trim the butts.*



*Dub the body forward, stopping where shown.*



*Align the tips of approx. 6 CDC feathers (the "trash" feathers are fine) and tie in as shown. Trim the butts and makes several*

# Eastern Sierra Report from Tom Loe of Sierra Drifters

## Quick look fish report 9/14/16

The Upper Owens has had a significant flow increase! This will improve conditions after the turbidity clears up. Flows have nearly doubled to 75cfs. Crowley has been kicking out numbers, & bigs. North End is most consistent; however Hilton, & McGee will also produce at times. Perch fry, & midge patterns are best. Middle Owens flows remain stable at 140cfs. Ideal for wading the wild trout section. Have caddis nymphs, & adults. Drifting has been very good at this release with some trophy rainbows on the bite. Streamers are the key to getting the bigs in the fall & winter. San Joaquin & Hot Creek have low water. East Walker flows have once again increased to 100cfs. Cooler water temps will make the fish more active. Aquatic weed issues remain. Pleasant Valley Reservoir levels are high, & flooded into the trees. Small river section good using dry/dropper combos. Alpine Lakes have good conditions. Get those full sinks, & larger streamers out for a shot at a large brown. Much cooler air temps to start the week; with a warming trend slated for the weekend.

## Crowley Lake 9/14/16

Hilton Bay has some nice browns cruising what is left of the weed lines. Tubers using perch fry can get into some numbers at times here. The North Arm has been exceptional some days, with McGee also having some hot bites. Look near the weeds in 7-11 feet. We are seeing a solid midge hatch during the high pressure periods. The sub-surface "mud lines" are in good water depths now. The larger fish continue to hunt the perch fry, and last of the damsel nymphs; but with the increased midge activity, one can fish chironomid patterns with consistent results. The submerged aquatic weeds are protruding making the weed lines easy to identify. Tubers should be looking to troll some larger streamers, & perch fry/damsel nymphs along these weed lines. Hang your flies above a clean mud bottom in close proximity to a hard weed line for consistent action. The fish are primarily hunting the larva close to the bottom. Broken back midges, crystal zebra, or

tiger midges (big ones), and damsel nymphs are all good calls while fishing below an "sliding" Under-cator. If you see those midges popping, get out those gillies, broken back gillies, & crystal emergers. My go to rig near the weeds has been an Assassin; or Drifters Punk Perch #14/16 as the upper, with a dark crystal tiger midge (#14), or broken back copper tiger (#16) as the larva pattern. Keep the tigers 6-12 inches off the deck. I have also been using twin Assassins; or a Punk Perch with an Assassin dropper along the weeds. Keep them a foot or more above the bottom. The rookies have been planted in numbers, so treat them with care. You may get into lots of sub-catchable rainbows & browns in some areas like Hilton Bay, or Crooked Creek..

## Upper Owens River 9/14/16

The LADWP is pulling water from Grant Lake & increasing flows. They have nearly doubled from the 40 cfs. that has been flowing for nearly a year with little fluctuation. After the turbidity decreases, & the fish adjust, conditions will be great. Added water will assist the fall run of browns, & rainbows if the flows continue at this release for a while. The bigs will begin to migrate upstream in October. Conditions are poor downstream from the Benton Bridge due to heavy aquatic weed growth. Upstream from the bridge special regulations apply, & the conditions are better above the confluence of Hot Creek inlets. Grasshopper activity slowing down. Use a stimulator with a bead head nymph like an Assassin, FB PT, olive crystal caddis; or olive zebra midge as a dropper. You will also see a decent caddis hatch, although I have not seen a great surface charge in a few trips here. Hi-vis caddis adult patterns used with a dropper can also get grabs. The water levels are very low above HC, & the irrigation canal inlets. You will find most of the planted rainbows, and wild browns in the deepest pools and pockets. There are a few nicer rainbows hanging around that are best fooled by attractor patterns like the "Drifters Crawler" and crystal eggs.

## Alpine Lakes 9/14/16

Fall comes earlier at higher elevations, & this can be the trigger to get some larger browns on the bite. Tubers trolling streamers with full sinking lines can get into some larger fish while targeting drop-offs, inlets, & structure. Agent Orange, Crystal Leeches, Loebergs, Spruce-A-Bu's, and Punk Perch patterns are good calls to use along drop-offs, structures like submerged stumps, and near inlets. Try dry dropper rigs using hi-vis mayfly patterns as your indicator/dry fly while suspending a small midge, Killa-baetis or Assassin nymph below it 2-3 feet during low light periods. The wild brookies and browns can be fooled using this technique during the warmer summer months.

## Middle Owens River (Bishop area) 9/14/16

Flows stabilizing around 135cfs. **making wading very safe & easy in the wild trout section. Caddis activity will remain solid through late October, with Trico mayflies showing when it begins to cool down in the Owens Valley. I would not hesitate to book a drift trip this fall as I believe the "catching" will be very good early on. Chub & sucker fry will be the primary target for the bigs, so have a selection of streamers like Loebergs, Spruce-A-Bu's, and Punk Perch with a moderate sinking tip line. Good nymphs to have are Assassins, flash back pheasant tails, Drifters Crawlers, olive crystal caddis, olive dubbed caddis, and broken back tiger/zebra midges.**






